News & Views (Christian Medical and Dental Association): Sex Of Any Kind Harms Teens

The Obama Administration wants the US to support the United Nations Economic, Social and Cultural Organization (UNESCO)'s global Education for All movement, aiming to meet the learning needs of all children, youth and adults by 2015. the guidelines were "co-authored by two leading experts in the field of sexuality education" – Dr. Doug Kirby, an adolescent sexuality expert, and Nanette Ecker, the former director of international education and training at the Sexuality Information and Education Council of the United States. Their report was based on a "rigorous review" of sex-ed literature, "drawing upon 87 studies from around the world," said Mark Richmond, director of UNESCO's Division for the Coordination of U.N. Priorities in Education, in an e-mailed statement. Sounds noble until you get to Part 2, Sexual Behavior, Key Concept 5 in the PDF at <http://www.unesco.org/en/efa-international-coordination/>

UNESCO officials said Richmond defended teaching about masturbation as "age-appropriate" because even in early childhood, "children are known to be curious about their bodies." Their lessons, he added, would hopefully help kids "develop a more complex understanding of sexual behavior" as they grow into adults.
